# **UMC GENERAL CONFERENCE 2024 (POSTPONED FROM 2020)**

General Conference is the highest legislative body in The United Methodist Church. It usually convenes once every four years to determine the denomination's future direction. Between 600 and 1000 delegates are elected by their annual conferences—half clergy and half laity, and up to 10 delegates. At General Conference, these delegates gather from all over the world to consider revisions to church law and the official ritual of the church, adopt resolutions on current moral, social, public policy and economic issues, and elect officers for a number of church-wide positions. The General Conference also approves plans and budgets for church-wide programs for the next four years. The General Conference postponed from 2020 will be meeting in Charlotte, North Carolina, April 23rd to May 3rd. Please pray for our Great Plains Delegates, clergy and laity:

#### Save the date and join us in our Summer Book Study

Beginning on June 3rd we will delve into the life of Corrie Ten Boom reading her story, "The Hiding Place".

Summary: At one time Corrie Ten Boom would have laughed at the idea that there would ever be a story to tell. For the first fifty years of her life nothing at all out of the ordinary had ever happened to her. She was an old-maid watchmaker living contentedly with her spinster sister and their elderly father in the tiny Dutch house over their shop. Their uneventful days, as regulated as their own watches, revolved around their abiding love for one another. However, with the Nazi invasion and occupation of Holland, a story did

ensue. Corrie ten Boom and her family became leaders in the Dutch Underground, hiding Jewish people in their home in a specially built room and aiding their escape from the Nazis. For their help, all but Corrie found death in a concentration camp. The Hiding Place is their story.

June 2nd—Letting God's light shine (who likes things that glow-in-the-dark?)


